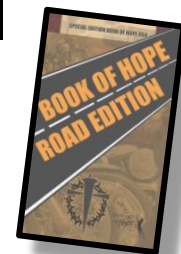

**RUN FOR THE WALL**



For years Assembly of God Chaplains have served on the largest national motorcycle ride in the country. This year Mark Rittermeyer (our lead MM chaplain) is the president of Run for the Wall and Russ Cockrum is the Central Route Coordinator. We have not had a presence on the Southern Route and the plan has been for me to work on that route. This year I will begin to do just that. Pray that God will allow me to have divine appointments and to be able to build relationships and during the ride. This ride began by honoring Vietnam veterans and trying to bring attention to soldiers missing in action and confined as prisoners of war, but has gone on to honor all of our veterans serving both then and in the war on terror today. Our budget for expenses during the ride is about \$2,500.
